All children develop in the context of relationships.




Relationships are fluid, blending the interactions between a child and another person.



Circles of socialization focus on recognizing the people, environments, and systems that directly or indirectly impact a child daily. By using the "circles of socialization lens" to understand and support the children in your programs, you can actively prevent adverse experiences.



We can visualize relationships as circular with the child in the center
